- Running time of all entries must be under five minutes or less to qualify for the competition
- All entries must be addressed **Five Minutes of Mystery Competition** and sent to **Compass Film CIC, 5, Walton Street, Bristol, BS6 0JG**
- Please submit DVD preview copy, even if the festival screening format is also DVD
- Please submit completed entry form duly signed & dated (failure to sign and date a form may result an entry being disqualified from selection)
- There is a space on the entry form for you to provide your own editorial for the film's programme notes, should it be selected for final screening. We reserve the right to edit this text as we see appropriate
- Films must be submitted on one of the following formats: DVD, Mini DV or full quality DV QuickTime files
- All deliveries from outside the EU to be indicated as 'non-commercial value – for cultural purposes only'
- Applicants must cover the cost of shipping entry form and screening copy
- We regret that we are not able to return copies of films submitted
